What is YMGE?


Yale Model Government Europe (YMGE) is an innovative, collaborative and inspiring conference that brings together top delegates from around the world and an experienced Yale Secretariat.

YMGE 2017 will take place in the beautiful city of Budapest from November 23 to 25, 2017. YMGE hopes to raise awareness of and foster debate about international relations and global affairs in the European context through simulations of global crises. Delegates will navigate an integrated crisis, spanning across all committees at the conference, that will force them to think on their feet and come up with solutions to new challenges in real time. Our conference will host a Keynote Speaker who will discuss the importance of international relations, collaboration among representatives, and understanding the global political climate.

Yale students will offer workshops on various topics. Previous workshops include: Yale Admissions, Writing College Applications, and current topics such as Nationalism in Europe and its global impacts.

Our conference will comprise two types of sessions. In standard committee debate, delegates will be placed in a parliament, European government, or supranational body to discuss important issues pertaining to the future of Europe and the international community. In crisis sessions, all committees will have to table their individual debates to come together and solve an issue that threatens the integrity of the international system and European integration.

Estimated delegate numbers are around 350-375 delegates from North America, South America, Europe, Africa, and Asia.







YMGE and YIRA

YMGE draws on the distinctive background and expertise of its parent organization, the Yale International Relations Association (YIRA), which has attained advisory status with the United Nations. As the largest undergraduate organizations at Yale University, YIRA organizes a wide range of programs and initiatives aimed at furthering knowledge and debate on global affairs.

YIRA is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit student organization at Yale University, of which Yale Model Government Europe is a constituent program. YIRA was founded in 1969 by a group of individuals who wished to promote a better understanding of global affairs after the events of the turbulent 1960s, YIRA's mission is to raise awareness of and foster debate about international relations and global affairs, through a number of unique programs. With 1,000 members hailing from more than 30 countries and pursuing virtually all courses of study, YIRA is one of the largest and most diverse student organizations at Yale University. YMGE consists of 24 dedicated Yale students who volunteer their time and efforts to produce the best YMGE yet.

Past dignitaries at the YIRA Speaker Series include Kofi Annan, Anna Vedouta, and Jolyon Howorth. Each semester, YIRA organizes several student-led political research trips to domestic and international destinations. Previous trips have engaged leaders in Cuba, the Balkans, the Philippines, NATO, Westminster, and the United Nations. Through Hemispheres, a community service project that pairs Yale undergraduates with New Haven youths, YIRA members educate the community about global affairs.
